Jetstar takes off to the South Pacific with first flights to Fiji

- Fly away to Fiji from \$189* one-way at Jetstar.com

Australia's low fares leader Jetstar has today celebrated its inaugural services to the South Pacific with direct flights to Fiji, one of the most popular destinations for Australian holidaymakers seeking a fun and friendly beach international getaway just four hours from Sydney.
