# Jetstar Asia mounts additional Penang flights to meet Lunar New Year demand

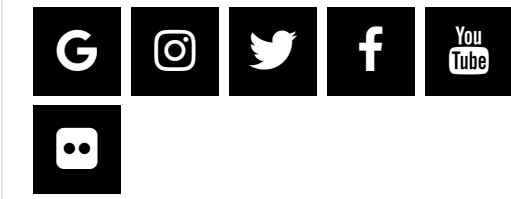
