Summer flights to Fiji in hot demand

Jetstar will offer eight supplementary return services from Sydney to Fiji between 14 December 2014 and 11 January 2015 to boost summer travel options for Australians*.

Jetstar Australia and New Zealand CEO David Hall said the airline was pleased to offer an additional 1,440 seats to the popular island destination over the school holidays.

“We know the demand for extra seats is there during the school holidays and we’re delighted more Australians will get the chance to experience all that Fiji has to offer.”

Jetstar commenced flying between Sydney and Fiji (Nadi) in March 2010. The additional services will depart Sydney on Monday and Friday evening, arriving in Fiji on Tuesday and Saturday morning respectively.

All flights will be operated by an Airbus A320 aircraft configured in a single class. Jetstar’s one-way lead-in fares on flights from Sydney to Fiji start from \$259**.
