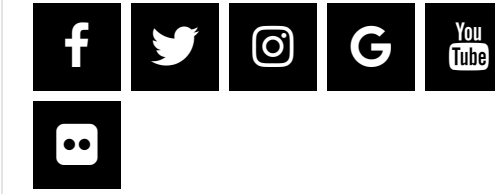

Jetstar to expand international network

- The longer range means direct flights from East Coast of Australia to Bali, not previously possible with A320 aircraft
- Frees up some Boeing 787s for new destinations and more flights to leisure routes such as Vietnam, China, Thailand and Hawaii

Cabin interior design

- Improved passenger comfort
- New slimline seats and extra baggage space
- More low fares: The larger A321 aircraft is longer and carries at least 40 more seats on each aircraft than the A320, which means more low fares
