Jetstar Asia Announces Two Exciting Direct Routes to Krabi and Clark



- Flights from Singapore to Krabi commence on 7 June 2024 with six weekly return services
- Services from Singapore to Clark restart on 16 June 2024 with four weekly return services, increasing to five weekly services from 18 October 2024
- On sale at 10am (SGT) today with special launch fares starting from just SG\$75[#] to Krabi and SG\$95[#] to Clark, one way on jetstar.com

Singapore: Jetstar Asia (3K) has announced the launch of two highly anticipated direct routes* to Krabi, Thailand, and Clark, Philippines, with fares on sale today, boosting international capacity out of Singapore.

Commencing on 7 June 2024, the Singapore-based low-cost carrier will fly six weekly return services to the stunning resort town of Krabi, offering over 60,000 low fares between Singapore and the popular holiday destination each year.

Flights to Clark will take off from Singapore's Changi International Airport on 16 June 2024, initially operating four weekly return services before increasing to five weekly services from 18 October 2024, serving more than 45,000 customers on the Clark route by the end of 2024.

Krabi, renowned for its stunning beaches and limestone cliffs, becomes an exciting addition to Jetstar Asia's portfolio of tropical getaways. Meanwhile, Clark, nestled in the heart of the Philippines, serves as a gateway to the country's vibrant culture and breathtaking landscapes.

Both routes will be operated on the airline's growing fleet of Airbus A320s and supported by Jetstar Asia's significant recruitment drive aimed at meeting the growing demand for travel within the region.

Jetstar Asia CEO, John Simeone said the move reinforced Jetstar Asia's commitment to expanding their Southeast Asian network and providing enhanced connectivity and a wide range of travel options for its customers.

"Our services to Clark are back by popular demand, not only for holiday makers but those wanting to visit family and friends," Mr. Simeone said.

"And Krabi is an exciting new addition for Jetstar Asia, less than two hours away, it's the perfect holiday destination for those wanting to enjoy stunning white beaches, world-class rock-climbing experiences, marine parks, rainforests and outdoor activities."

"We're excited to add these two popular destinations, responding to demand, providing our customers with more incredible low-cost travel options and supporting the travel and tourism industries in these two critical markets."

Noel Manankil, President and CEO of LIPAD, manager and operator of Clark International Airport said that they are delighted to welcome Jetstar flights back here to Clark International Airport (CRK).

"Clark Airport has always been a home to Jetstar and we are happy to serve their passengers again. This partnership provides passengers the opportunity to experience a seamless and memorable airport journey," Mr. Manankil said.

To celebrate, Jetstar Asia will launch special one-way fares from Singapore to Krabi from SG\$75[#] and Singapore to Clark from SG\$95[#] available on jetstar.com from 10:00 (SGT) today, 5 March 2024.
