- CORRESPONDENCE FROM COURTS

We refer to the letter from Providence Law Asia LLC dated 13 February 2026.

2 The Claimant and/or its solicitors are to give immediate notice of the following directions for the hearing of SIC/OA 4/2026 fixed on 4 March 2026, 9:00 AM, Singapore time (the "**Hearing**"), to all who may be affected by the orders sought in SIC/OA 4/2026:

(a) The Hearing before the Honourable Justice Christopher Scott Sontchi will be conducted in the Zoom webinar format, to support a potentially large number in attendance.

(b) The Zoom webinar registration link for the hearing is: <https://go.gov.sg/siccwebinarhearing>. Persons who wish to attend the Hearing (including the Consumer Creditors and Non-Consumer Creditors who have filed reply affidavits and/or written submissions) are required to register via this link to obtain the Zoom meeting ID and password ("Webinar Hearing Details"). For avoidance of doubt, the Zoom meeting ID and password provided in the Registrar's Notice – Virtual Hearing Details issued on 4 February 2026 will be superseded by the Webinar Hearing Details.

(c) Access to the Hearing will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis. For those who are unable to log in for the Hearing, please note that the Hearing will be transcribed. A copy of the official transcription will be made available after the Hearing to assist the creditors and anyone else having an interest in SIC/OA 4/2026. The Claimant's solicitors will be directed to disseminate a copy of the official transcription to all concerned.

(d) In relation to the Zoom webinar format of the hearing, all who will be logging in for the Hearing are to note the following:

i. attendees should use the raise hand feature in the Zoom webinar if they wish to address the Court. If permission is granted to address the Court, they should turn on their cameras and microphones when

addressing the Court. Attendees are otherwise not allowed to address the Court or turn on their cameras;

ii. watermarking technology will be used and only users with a registered Zoom account will be able to log in to the webinar (registration can be done at <https://zoom.us/signup>); and

iii. any unauthorised recording or dissemination of video/audio footage of the Hearing is prohibited and may be the subject of thorough investigations that can result in civil and/or criminal liability.

(e) Save as otherwise varied by the directions above, all directions in the correspondence from court dated 3 February 2026 remain.

3 To facilitate the Claimant's notification of the Court's directions in paragraph 2 above, the Claimant may share the Webinar Hearing Details with the Claimant's international legal counsel from Ashurst LLP and the Claimant's proposed Scheme Manager, Mr Joshua Taylor of Alvarez & Marsal (SE Asia) Pte Ltd.
