- CORRESPONDENCE FROM COURTS

We refer to SIC/OA 16/2026 ("OA 16") and the letter from Providence Law Asia LLC dated 16 April 2026 (the "Letter").

- 2 Please be informed that OA 16 will be heard before the Honourable Justice Christopher Scott Sontchi.
- 3 The Court directs as follows:
 - (a) The timelines as set out at paragraph 5 of the Letter are approved.
 - (b) The hearing of OA 16 is fixed on Thursday, 21 May 2026 at 9am Singapore time (the "Hearing") and will be conducted by way of a Zoom webinar format. The Zoom webinar registration link for the hearing is: <https://go.gov.sg/siccwebinarhearing>. Persons who wish to attend the Hearing (including the Consumer Creditors and Non-Consumer Creditors who have filed reply affidavits and/or written submissions) are required to register via this link to obtain the Zoom meeting ID and password ("Webinar Hearing Details"). Consumer Creditors who have only registered for the Zoom webinar hearing (i.e., they have not filed a reply affidavit and/or written submissions) may only observe and may not participate in any way.
 - (c) The Claimant is to commence notifying all creditors of the timelines issued in respect of OA 16 by way of email notification and update to the Scheme Website within one working day from receipt of this letter.
 - (d) Access to the Hearing will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis. For those who are unable to log in for the Hearing, please note that the Hearing will be transcribed. A copy of the official transcription will be made available after the Hearing to assist the creditors and anyone else having an interest in OA 16. The Claimant's solicitors will be directed to disseminate a copy of the official transcription to all concerned.
 - (e) In relation to the Zoom webinar format of the hearing, all who will be logging in for the Hearing are to note

the following:

- (i) Attendees should use the raise hand feature in the Zoom webinar if they wish to address the Court. If permission is granted to address the Court, they should turn on their cameras and microphones when addressing the Court. Attendees are otherwise not allowed to address the Court or turn on their cameras;
- (ii) Watermarking technology will be used and only users with a registered Zoom account will be able to log in to the webinar (registration can be done at <https://zoom.us/signup>); and
- (iii) Any unauthorised recording or dissemination of video/audio footage of the Hearing is prohibited and may be the subject of thorough investigations that can result in civil and/or criminal liability.

(f) The Claimant is to write in, by 10am Singapore time on 19 May 2026, to indicate the names of the individuals who are expected to attend the Hearing.
